I am a Lafayette, Louisiana-based athletic professional with a passion for coaching, education, and youth development. Grounded in a strong Catholic faith that guides everything I do, I approach my work with purpose, integrity, and a servant's heart. My journey in athletics began at Teurlings Catholic High School, where I graduated with the Class of 2015. I earned a starting role at strong safety on the football team as a sophomore and competed at a high level throughout my high school career — an experience that instilled in me the discipline, competitiveness, and love for the game that I carry to this day.

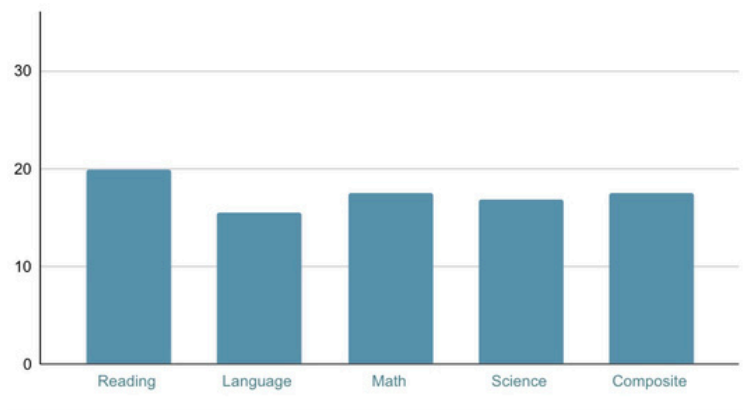
After high school, I was blessed to receive a full academic and athletic scholarship to Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, where I continued to grow as both a student and an athlete. I later transferred to the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, where I earned my Bachelor of Applied Science. I am also a proud member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., an organization that has deeply shaped my commitment to leadership, scholarship, and community service. My coaching career has taken me across multiple sports, settings, and age groups — from young children discovering athletics for the first time to high school competitors chasing championships. At Carencro High School and Comeaux High School, I coached football and track & field, pouring everything I had into the development of my student-athletes. One of my proudest moments came in my very first year as a track coach, when I guided a triple jumper to the LHSA State Championship at LSU while he set a new personal record. Moments like that remind me why I do what I do. As a certified personal trainer, I also helped a client gain 42 pounds of lean mass over three years through a structured program — proof that with the right plan and the right mindset, transformation is possible.

Beyond coaching, I spent three years as a classroom teacher at Carencro High School, where I learned how to connect with students, manage diverse learning environments, and contribute to a positive school culture. My time as Assistant General Manager at Urban Air Adventure Park added another layer to my leadership toolkit, giving me hands-on experience in staff training, operations, and program coordination.

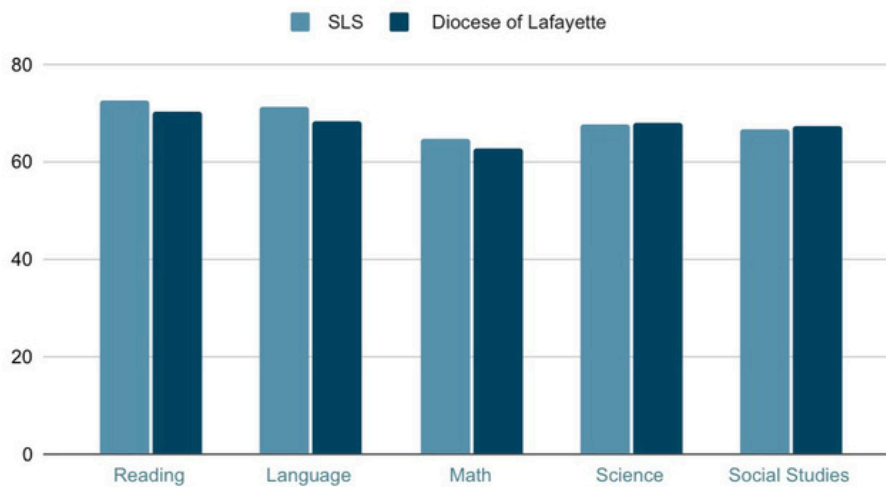

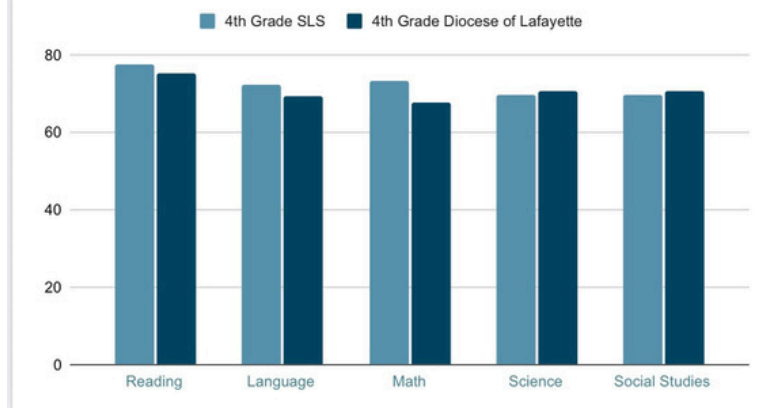
PreACT Averages SLS
